



The Advanced Practice Registered Nurse Loan Repayment Program is a program funded by the State of Georgia to provide loans of up to \$10,000 to assist advanced practice registered nurses in repaying outstanding APRN education loan debt in return for practicing in an underserved rural Georgia county (a population of 35,000 or less based on the most recent U.S. Census). Contracts are awarded for one year and are renewable three times for a maximum of four years. Please see the chart below for information about the program.

<p>Who can apply?</p>	<p>Applicants must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •be a citizen, legal resident or foreign national of the U.S., •graduated from an institution of nursing education that received accreditation or provisional accreditation by a national accrediting body in nursing education designed to qualify the graduate for licensure by the Georgia Board of Nursing, •have satisfied all requirements for unrestricted APRN licensure by the Georgia Board of Nursing, •must work in a qualifying practice that actively treats Medicaid patients
<p>When should I apply?</p>	<p>The application period runs from Sept. 1 through Oct. 31 on the GBPW website</p>
<p>What is the amount of the award?</p>	<p>The award amount is \$10,000 per year and is renewable for up to three additional years (maximum of \$40,000/four years). The program assists in paying debt incurred for tuition, fees and other expenses associated with the completion of an APRN degree and available on a first-come, first-serve basis.</p>
<p>What is the renewal process?</p>	<p>Applicants must reapply each year, and if there are no substantial changes over the previous year, the application will be automatically renewed. However, substantial changes will require the application to be ranked as a new application.</p>
<p>What is the service repayment?</p>	<p>One year of working full-time in a Georgia County of 50,000 or less for each year of funding received</p>
<p>What are the penalties for not completing the obligation?</p>	<p>Double the principal amount received</p>
