

The Georgia Board of Health Care Workforce manages a state initiative aimed at aiding dentists in repaying their educational loans acquired during dental school. The Dentists for Rural Areas Assistance Program offers loans of up to \$25,000 per year that can be canceled through service, provided that the recipient practices dentistry in underserved rural areas of Georgia with populations of 50,000 or fewer. Contracts are awarded for one year and are renewable for a maximum of four years. The program is financially supported by the State of Georgia. For program details, please refer to the chart below.
