The Georgia Board of Health Care Workforce co-sponsors “practice opportunity fairs” each year in conjunction with graduate medical education programs. These job fair-style events link resident physicians with employment opportunities around the Peach State. Invited participants are resident physicians of Georgia-based GME programs and any hospital or clinic recruiting for practice opportunities in Georgia only.

In FY 2020, three physician residency programs across the state teamed up with the GBHCW to host fairs. Below are total figures and a breakdown of participation at each event.
